Day 1: Scenic Views & Local Art


As you set off toward Mentone, let the drive up Highway 117 be your first taste of adventure. Winding through breathtaking mountain scenery, the journey itself is an experience—so take your time! Pause at the scenic pullouts to capture the stunning views, breathe in the crisp mountain air, and let the beauty around you set the tone for an unforgettable trip.

Next, drive over to **DeSoto Falls**, one of Alabama's most breathtaking waterfalls, perfect for a morning stroll and some beautiful photos to capture the views. Breathe in the fresh mountain air as you watch the water cascade over rocky cliffs —a peaceful prelude to your afternoon.

At lunchtime, check out <u>Fontastic Foods Food</u> <u>Trucks</u>, where you can sample a variety of gourmet flavors in a casual, outdoor setting. From there, make your way to the heart of Mentone to enjoy some local art at the <u>Mentone</u> <u>Arts Center</u>, where talented local and regional artists display their work, adding a touch of culture to your day.





For dinner, unwind at <u>Elevation Bistro</u>, a cozy spot featuring creative dishes made from fresh ingredients. Before you plan your dinner time, make sure you check sunset times. You don't want to miss the sunset over the Appalachian Mountains from <u>Brow Park</u>. It's an idyllic setting to end your first day, as the sun dips behind the hills, painting the sky with vibrant hues—a truly magical way to conclude a day of scenic beauty and local charm.

After your wind down with dinner and a sunset, head to your accommodation of choice.  - A unique gift shop nestled near the Log Cabin Village in downtown Mentone, Alabama.
- Mentone Arts Center
 - Browse artwork from local and regional artists, adding a bit of culture to your day.

- Brow Park
 - Enjoy a beautiful Appalachian sunset at Brow Park. The perfect spot to wind down and enjoy the end of your first day.
- Elevation Bistro
 - Unwind with an inventive dinner featuring fresh ingredients in a cozy atmosphere.

Round out your afternoon with a round of golf at <u>Lil' Mole Run Golf Course</u> or an antique hunt at <u>Ayers Antiques</u>, both perfect options to add a little leisure and nostalgia to your day. If it's blueberry season, wrap up the afternoon with a visit to <u>Blueberry Falls Farm</u> for a relaxing stroll and some fresh-picked blueberries.

Dinner awaits at <u>Wildflower Cafe</u>, an iconic Mentone establishment known for its artistic charm and delicious favorites like tomato pie. Reservations are recommended to make sure you don't miss out on this unforgettable dining experience. EVENING

- Dinner Wildflower Cafe
 - Enjoy dinner at this iconic, artistic cafe known for local favorites like the famous tomato pie. Reservations recommended.
