



Heritage & Hosiery

Cherokee Indian Chief Sequoyah perfected his "Talking Leaves" alphabet here in DeKalb County that incited a whole Cherokee Nation to learn how to read and write in a matter of a few weeks.

The Little River is the only river in the world to run its full length across the top of a mountain. The river stretches across Lookout Mountain, forming Desoto Falls – a 104-ft waterfall.

Little River Canyon National Preserve

The Little River is the only river in the world to run its full length across the top of a mountain.

The Canyon reaches depths of 600 feet and has an 11-mile canyon rim drive.

Little River is unique because it flows for most of its length atop Lookout Mountain in northeast Alabama. Located on the boundary of DeKalb and Cherokee Counties, in the rugged yet verdant landscape of northeast Alabama, the authorized boundary of the preserve currently contains 15,288 acres, 11,042 acres of which are federally owned and managed. Forested uplands, waterfalls, canyon rims and bluffs, pools, boulders, and sandstone cliffs offering settings for a variety of recreational activities. Natural resources and cultural heritage come together to tell the story of the Preserve, a special place in the Southern Appalachians.

Little River Canyon National
Preserve is divided into three parts:
Scenic Canyon Rim Drive, Backcountry
Area and Canyon Mouth Park. There are
also two waterfalls along AL Highway
35 that people also like to visit (Little
River Falls from Boardwalk and Little
Falls).

The Scenic Drive

The Scenic Drive offers an eleven mile drive down AL Highway 176 with eight overlooks to stop and enjoy the scenery. Very little walking is required to enjoy the views. Picnic tables are available along the scenic drive. There are trails available if you would like to explore. Hiking trails range from easy to arduous/steep and from half a mile in length to two miles. Keep in mind that unless the trail is a loop, that you will need to hike that distance back out.

The Backcountry Area

The Backcountry Area has about 23 miles of dirt roads that are great for horseback riding. Hunting and fishing are allowed in this area during specified times and dates (users must adhere to Alabama Hunting & Fishing Regulations). There is also a popular swimming area called High Rock found off of Road 05. DeSoto Scout Trails and the YCC Loop to Road 10 trail are found in this area.

Canyon Mouth Park

Canyon Mouth Park is a popular place to picnic, and spend the day near the water. There is a \$15 day-use fee per vehicle. A \$35 Annual pass is available. Restrooms are available at this location. There is also a pavilion available to rent.

Waterfalls

Little River Falls offers a paved 165-car parking lot with a boardwalk leading west down to the falls. The parking lot is located next to the AL Hwy 35 bridge. Restrooms and picnic tables are available (no reservations).

There is also a hiking trail from the main parking lot that leads you to Little Falls. This is a very popular attraction for people that want to be near the water.

Accessibility

Little River Canyon National Preserve is largely wooded with only a few trails. The National Park Service strives to make the park as universally accessible as possible.

Your first stop is the Little River Canyon Center located at 4322 Little River Trail NE, Fort Payne, AL 35967. (GPS address: 472 Alabama Hwy 35). This building is accessible to wheelchairs and persons with disabilities. You can watch the movie which has captions for the hearing impaired and get maps of the area.

Little River Falls has a boardwalk that leads you down to a close-up view of the waterfall. There are picnic tables available near the parking lot.

The scenic drive offers a boardwalk on the first overlook, "Little River Falls Boardwalk", it gives you a faraway view of the falls. For additional information concerning accessibility, please contact the Little River Canyon National Preserve office at 256-845-9605.



Operating Hours, Fees and Current Weather Conditions

Hours for the business office for Little River Canyon National Preserve are: Hours: Monday - Friday 8:00 AM until 4:00 PM (CST) Central Standard Time. Closed on all federal holidays.

The Scenic Drive/Overlooks, Little River Falls, Little Falls and the Backcountry Area are open daily during daylight hours.

The **Visitor Center** is located at the Little River Canyon Center. Please call for hours, as they vary.

Canyon Mouth Park is a Day-Use Area located in Cedar Bluff, Alabama. Please call for hours, as they vary based on season. Cars within the gates after hours are subject to be ticketed and/or towed.



DeSoto State Park This 3,502-acre park is accented by many rushing waterfalls and fragrant wildflowers.

Continuing in the rustic tradition of the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC), mountainous Desoto State Park is nestled atop beautiful Lookout Mountain in scenic Northeast Alabama and accented by many rushing waterfalls and fragrant wildflowers that will simply take your breath away. Developed in the late 1930s, the hard-working and dedicated men of the CCC made many natural enhancements to the park that have withstood the test of time and will last for future generations. Come commune with Mother Nature as DeSoto State Park offers a family-friendly atmosphere that holds wonders for people of all ages!

Lodging

This 3,502-acre park provides lodging facilities including: Mountain Chalets, Log and Rustic Cabins, Motel Rooms, and an Improved Campground with 94 full-hookup tent and RV sites. For the more adventurous, there are also a primitive campground for tents, with 1 camping cabin and 2 backcountry campsites with shelter to hike into. No matter what type of lodging you might prefer or have need of, we have it!

DeSoto State Park is conveniently located only 8 miles northeast of Fort Payne, Alabama; and DeSoto Falls - also part of DeSoto State Park - is located about 7 miles north of the park heading towards Mentone, Alabama.

Amenities

Other amenities include a restaurant, meeting rooms, pavilions, picnic area with playground, olympic-size swimming pool (seasonal), the Benefield Interpretive Center with featured interpretive programs and live animals, a Civilian Conservation Corps museum, and more than 30 miles of hiking and mountain biking trails; we even have an ADA-accessible boardwalk trail dedicated to Talmadge Butler, a former park superintendent. There is a small fee in the main picnic area, and in DeSoto Falls Picnic Area.












Nature

Secluded in a natural pocket of the Appalachian Mountain foothills, the pocket itself is on an upstream tributary of Lake Guntersville. Seven miles down stream at Morgan's Cove is a boat launch and fishing area on Lake Guntersville.

Camping

The campground features 23 campsites with 13 of those being sewer hook-up sites, 4 of those being pull-through sites and 10 of those providing water and electricity. Each of these sites features a 16' x 60' concrete camper pad, picnic table, firepit and grill. There are also 11 primitive campsites located within the interior of the campground and more planned for the future. The campground is conveniently located to the new ORV trail. Back country sites are also planned for the future.

A bathhouse, separate ADA bathhouse and dump station are provided. Other campground amenities include:

- · One ADA accessible campsite (no sewer hook-up)
- · High speed WiFi within the main campground
- · Pavilion rental in common area

Hiking

Hiking Trails are plentiful in the park. With 15 miles of trails you will surely find a favorite. All the trails hold a new adventure each time you visit.





ORV Trails

Discover some of Alabama's most beautiful and rugged terrain on the new ORV trail at Buck's Pocket State Park. The ORV trail was designed to be a slow ride through beech/hardwood forest, paralleling South Sauty Creek. The trail passes through the creek side primitive campsite area, across Morgan's Cove lake access area and continues another 2.3 miles. The trail is conveniently located with access to the newly renovated campground. Along the 6.3 mile ORV trail, there are many opportunities for scenic views to see some of Northeast Alabama's unique flora and fauna. In addition, there are a few locations to picnic and fish. ORV's must utilize the campground/park office area only to register and access the trail.

The newest jewel in the Fort Payne parks department is the Alabama Walking Park. It is located on 5th Street SW behind the Depot Museum. It has 2 brand new playgrounds, one for older kids and one for tots. Douglas Community Park

Newly refurbished, City Park is the oldest park in Fort Payne. It is located in downtown on the corner of Gault Avenue and 5th Street. Hawkins Spring Park

Hawkins Spring Park is located just off of Highway 35 at the base of scenic Lookout Mountain. It features a wonderful playground as well as picnic areas and a picnic shelter. Patriots Memorial Park

Spring Grove is located in South Fort Payne on Turner Avenue South directly behind the Dekalb County Council on Aging. 





FORT PAYNE OPERA HOUSE
Listed on the National Register of
Historical Places and the National
Register of 19th Century Theatres in America,
the facility is the only opera house in the state
still in use as a theatre. Upkeep and maintenance on this beautiful building continues.
Tours on Thur, Fri, & Sat from 10am – 3pm.

Part of the historic opera block, the hall is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is used for Landmarks meetings, exhibits and public events. Exhibit tours on Thur, Fri, Sat from 10am – 3pm. 514 Gault Ave. N, Fort Payne.

HOSIERY MUSEUM
Located next door to Hunt Hall and also listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Museum houses exhibits from the industry's beginning through its zenith when Fort Payne was "The Sock Capitol of the World". Additional display materials and photographs are being sought. Tours on Thur, Fri, & Sat from 10am – 3pm. 514 Gault Ave. N, Fort Payne.



Part of local property seized by Federal Troops in 1837 to establish a fort for Indian removal. The Benge Detachment, with over 1000 Cherokee, left Fort Payne in October 1838. Research indicates the cabin belonged to a Cherokee, Spirit or John Huss. The site has been certified as an official component of the Trail of Tears National Historic Trail and is open to the public during daylight hours. 106 4th St, Fort Payne.

WILLS VALLEY SCHOOL

The school has a rich history in the role of education in DeKalb County. Completed in the fall of 1907, the building consisted of two large rooms on the first floor for class purposes and two rooms on the second floor, one used as an Odd Fellow Hall and the other as living quarters for the principal and his family. 1320 Co Rd 27, Fort Payne.



The last remaining one room school-house in the county was built near the top of Sand Mountain in 1903. This charming structure is still used for occasional Landmarks functions and Sacred Harp singings. Much needed repairs are being done as funding is available. The property is listed on the Alabama Register of Landmarks and Heritage. Open to the public during daylight hours.



WILLSTOWN MISSION CEMETERY
The Willstown Mission was established in 1823 to offer instruction in English, vocational arts and Christian religion to the Cherokees. Nothing remains of the mission/school. The cemetery contains the graves of Rev. Ard Hoyt, early white settlers and possible Cherokee burials. It has been designated by the National Park Service as a historic site on the Trail of Tears and is open to the public during daylight hours. 314 38th St. NE, Fort Payne.

This was once a thriving mining community that was spread in a north-south line along the foot of Lookout Mountain in Valley Head. Landmarks is working to develop the property as a historic park with walking, hiking and biking trails.

This historic structure is now operated as
The Big Mill Co. Artisans and Antiques and

THE FORT PAYNE DEPOT MUSEUM
The Richardson Rmanesque-style depot was built in 1891 and now functions as a museum with exhibits from 1800s and 1900s. 105 5th St NE, Fort Payne.

THE SAWYER BUILDING
This Victorian commercial structure is the location of Landmark's Boom Town
Makers' Market. Corner of Gault Ave & 4th St
NW, Fort Payne.



FORT PAYNE COAL & IRON BUILDING

Built in 1889, the building's first tenants included the Fort Payne Coal and Iron Company offices and the Bank of Fort Payne. Today the facility is used for community events. 500 Gault Ave. N, Fort Payne.





Waterfalls Head into the woods on hiking trails & paths to DeKalb's most scenic waterfalls.

GRACE'S HIGH FALLS

Located within the 14,000 acres of Little River Canyon National Preserve is Graces' High Falls. Though only visible seasonally, this waterfall is one of Alabama's highest falls.

Plunging 133 feet into the canyon below, the waterfall features a view you can't find anywhere else. When rainfall is high, a significant amount of smaller creeks and waterfalls can be seen while exploring this area.



AZALEA CASCADE

This small cascade flows into a pool located at the end of the Talmadge Butler Boardwalk Trail.

Azalea Falls may also be reached by following the red trail located behind the Country Store which sits at the center of DeSoto State Park.



DESOTO FALLS

One of the most photographed points of interest in Alabama, Desoto Falls is also one of the tallest, standing at 104 feet, and most visited waterfalls in Alabama. It also features numerous smaller falls and area trails to view the falls from a variety of angles.


The waterfall has a concrete dam above the falls, which was built in 1925 for Alabama's first hydroelectric power plant. Now the park's boathouse serves as a place to rent kayaks and ride Little River above the falls.



LODGE FALLS

This easy to find waterfall is suitably named due to its location just behind DeSoto's Lodge. Lodge Falls drops about 25 feet and is rainfall dependent.

The best view point of this waterfall is reached by hiking down into a small ravine and jumping on the yellow trail for a short distance, then coming back out next to the Lodge.



INDIAN FALLS

This interesting waterfall drops about 20 feet into a small ravine, located just across the road from the Talmadge Butler Trailhead.

Indian Falls is about 0.1 miles from the trailhead and is easily reached over a small footpath. A wooden footbridge crosses over the top of this beautiful sight, connecting hikers back to the yellow trail.



LITTLE RIVER FALLS

Little River falls flows in one of America's deepest and most extensive canyon systems east of the Mississippi River. Little River Canyon National Preserve is 14,000 acres of picturesque beauty.

Located at the north end of the Canyon, visitors can marvel at Little River Falls - one of Alabama's most scenic waterfalls.



LITTLE FALLS

This popular fall is better known by locals as "the hippie hole" and has fast become one of the most visited swimming areas at Little River Canyon National Preserve.

Parking is available off Highway 35, near Road 861, and is accessible by a partially rugged mile long trail.



POISON IVY FALLS

This large seasonal waterfall is the hardest to get to. Located on the strenuous Desoto Scout Trail-between DST Exit 1 & 2.

It can be reached via the Gilliam Loop Trailhead/CCC Road to Exit 1 & 2. Water-level dependent.



LOST FALLS

This waterfall is the most difficult to find in DeSoto State Park. When water levels are low and the fall is not flowing, it can appear truly lost.

The best time to see this small 5 foot waterfall is in spring or winter seasons. Lost Falls is located about 1.5 miles from Desoto's Country Store and terrain can vary between moderate and mild.



LAUREL FALLS

This small but beautiful waterfall can be found off of the orange trail and falls about 6 feet. It is located approximately 3/4 of a mile from Desoto's Country Store with the trail varying between rugged and moderate with some uphill climbs.



HIGH FALLS

Marvel at the scenic vistas and this majestic 35-foot waterfall, which is the centerpiece of High Falls Park. Formed by Town Creek, the falls span some 300 feet across at times. Near the base of the impressive High Falls is a natural bridge. This 25-feet span of rock features a large arch, eroded by the flow of water over hundreds of years.
